### **Saint Vincent La Soufriere Volcano: Appeal for Financial Aid**

I believe we are all aware of the eruption of the Saint Vincent, La Soufriere Volcano on 9<sup>th</sup> April 2021, and the devastation of the course and quality of life and homes, there and on neighbouring islands. Whilst there has been no loss of life, to date, we are deeply moved by the major disruption caused by the ongoing eruptions, wide dispersal of residual ash, which may last for several weeks.
